They clean by hammering action. The profile they produce is much rounder then that achieved by similar shot of iron abrasives. Providing a muted finish to metal.

The important point to remember is to choose an abrasive of the lowest hardness needed to achieve the profile and speed of cleaning required.

The harder the abrasive, the shorter life because of its tendency to fracture more quickly. It means higher abrasive costs and increase wear on machine parts.
