Statement

All directors are responsible of maintaining and reviewing their own and their employees health & safety.

Risk Assessment

The main risks are with operation of the forklift, manual handling of products, moving around the works spaces, and office based risks (e.g. RSI)

Accident Prevention

Operation of Forklift

The forklift should only be operated by competent trained directors. Extra care should be taken when there are third parties on site e.g. lorry drivers to ensure they are kept away from operating areas.

Manual Handling

The maximum weight to be lifted by one person is 25 kilos. Directors should make themselves familiar with the Manual Handling Guidance Note as issued by the HSE.

Office Based risks

Lighting is provided to a sufficient standard to ensure safe working. Directors should not spend prolonged periods at computer keyboards and should also position the monitor and keyboard to minimize eye and wrist strain. All electrical equipment must be maintained

Works Space

Appropriate clothing is required in diffrenet work areas, correct signage should be used around the work place.
